HOW OUR SYSTEM WORKS

- Create a profile by going to www.myVolunteerPage.com and entering CINCINNATI in the search box.
- Select Welcomers Community Volunteer Network from the list and create your username and password, choosing something that will be secure but easy to remember.
- Complete the profile, filling in each field with an asterisk.
- Under "Additional Info," choose how often you want to be informed about volunteer opportunities: 1 - Email me with newly added opportunities; 2 - Email me periodically (no more than quarterly); 3 - Do NOT email me.
- If sent to www.myVolunteerPage.com by an organization, use your already established username and password to log into the site; your basic information will already be in place. Simply complete any "Additional Info" that is requested.
- Sign up for shifts that meet your availability.
- Print your monthly calendar of assignments.



ADDITIONAL SOFTWARE BENEFITS

- Start and end shifts in person or via apps on your own smartphone or tablet.
- Communicate with your organizations via the web site.
