Getting Things Done in Ohio

ServeOhio improves academic achievement by supporting **AmeriCorps members serving in 375 schools and Education Centers** across Ohio. **AmeriCorps members tutor, mentor, and teach more than 50,000 students** – increasing attendance rates and course completion – helping students build successful strategies for high school graduation, targeted higher education pursuits, and meaningful employment opportunities to achieve long-term life goals.

ServeOhio builds skills and increases employment opportunities for the 800 individuals now serving as AmeriCorps members. **Ohio AmeriCorps members will receive over 137,000 hours of professional development and training, and will earn over \$3.9 million in education awards** that can be used to pay for post-secondary education or qualified student loans. Since the inception of AmeriCorps in 1994, Ohio residents have qualified for more than \$99 million in AmeriCorps education awards – a valuable resource that significantly reduces student debt.
